This policy applies to school events, school residential camps, and alternative learning sessions.

At The Outdoor Ed School, we prioritize creating a focused, immersive, and safe environment during our outdoor activities.

To ensure all participants and students get the most out of their experience, we kindly request that phones and other personal electronic devices be put away during all activities.

Policy Details:

- **No Phone Usage During Activities:** All mobile phones must be turned off or stored securely in personal bags or designated areas during activities.
- **Emergency Contact:** If there is a need for emergency contact, please inform our staff beforehand. We will make provisions for urgent communication if required.
- **Respectful Engagement:** Phones can be a distraction to the group dynamic and safety. By keeping devices away, everyone can be fully engaged with the activity, the environment, and fellow participants.
- **No Photos:** Participants are not allowed to capture any photos or videos throughout their experience. This is to protect other participants from having their image captured without consent.
- **Exceptions:** Phones may be used during scheduled breaks or if there is a genuine emergency. However, please limit use during these times to avoid distractions.
